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Carl Sagan and Ann Druyan say:

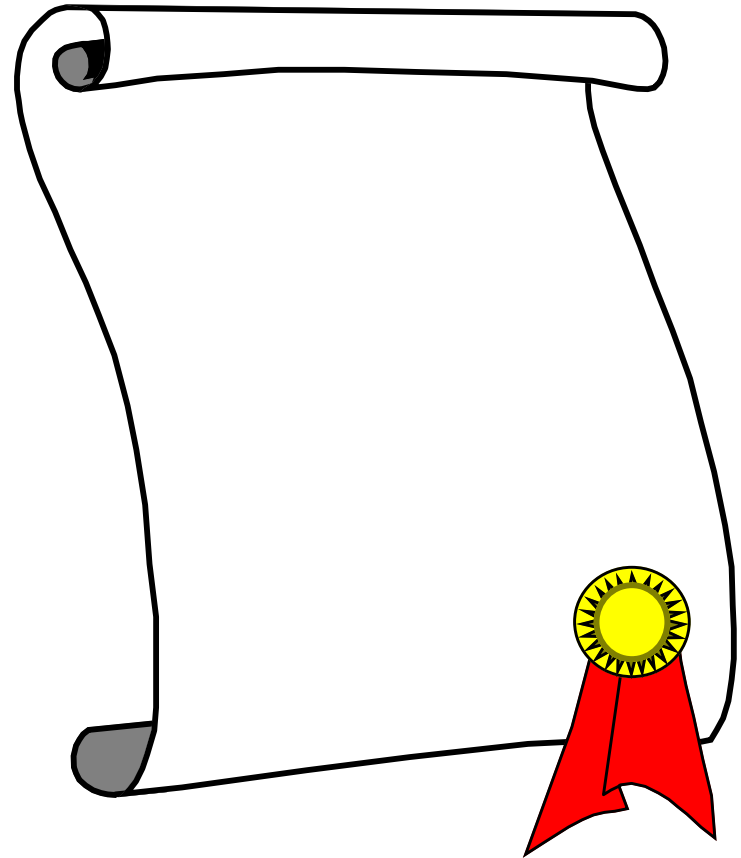
- **Books... permit us to interrogate the past with high accuracy; to tap the wisdom of our species; to understand the point of view of others.... Books are the key to understanding the world and participating in a democratic society.”**



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What is GOOD literature?

- it is **ENGAGING** -- it pulls the reader into itself for a time.
- it is **TRUTH** -- it reflects what is real, but not necessarily literal.



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How do students **BENEFIT?**



- See **THEMSELVES**
- See **COMMON BONDS**
- See **MULTIPLE PERSPECTIVES**
- See authenticated a **LARGER VARIETY** of students than traditional canon.

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Teach MC as LITERATURE!!!

- **Not necessary to teach multicultural selection as an *ethnic* work.**
- **Let different races be *incidental* to the unit.**
- **Use such MC authors as Hurston, Erdrich, Anaya, and Kingston just because they are writers of **GOOD LITERATURE.****



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Good MC literature can reveal:

- the power of poetic language
- the emotional upheavals of coming of age
- the need for intergenerational respect
- that one must live with the results of ones choice



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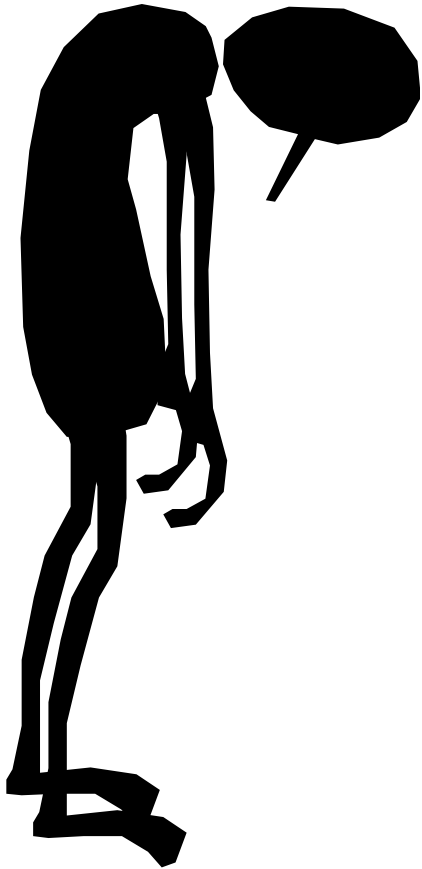
Meeting OBJECTIONS
