 - ii. Is it organized logically? Chronological or spatial?
 - iii. Does solution solve problem in practical way?
 - iv. Does the sentence structure reflect the emotion of the incident?
 - v. Does the variety of references add weight to the arguments?
 - c. Conclusion – Does speech end without introducing new ideas? Does the conclusion challenge the audience to act in way that will solve problems?
